### This week

#### Year 4 class assembly by Jessica J (Kestrels)

Our assembly was fantastic! We spoke about gods, hieroglyphics, mummification, a Howard Carter play and lots more. We showed the parents everything that we had learnt. It was fun for the children and interesting for the parents.

The hieroglyphics section was very funny, especially how they said "and now hierrrrrrrooglyphics!" when they introduced it. Some children read the mummy section from "13 Steps To Be An Ancient Egyptian", others showed posters. We spoke about the pyramids of Giza, showed scarab amulets and told the parents about Canopic jars whilst showing some of the ones that we made.

#### **Parking**

Unfortunately, we have had more residents complaining this week about parents parking across their driveways in Rectory Lane at the beginning and end of the school day, making it impossible for them to exit or gain access to their property. We are extremely fortunate to have car parking facilities at the children's centre and urge parents to use this instead of parking on Rectory Lane. We have taken steps and contacted East Herts Council who are advising that residents affected by this take the registration numbers of parents obstructing their driveways and contact them directly. We will be informing residents of this advice so that they can follow procedure in case of an obstruction.

#### Top 10 Attendance and Punctuality Tips

As you are aware, children are expected to have at least 95% attendance and be in school by 8.50am. We still have many children arrive after this time and they are missing the first lesson of the day that starts at 8.50am. Here are some suggestions to help you achieve this:

- 1) Establish a good routine in the mornings and evenings so your child is prepared for the school day ahead. Have book bags ready by the door and packed lunches made the night before.
- 2) Make sure you leave plenty of time to get to school and leave additional time if you drive or use public transport (especially on bad weather days when more people may choose to drive).
- 3) Ensure your child arrives at school on time not late. The gate is locked at 8.55am.
- 4) Arrange dental and non-urgent medical appointments outside school hours. This includes 6 monthly dental checkups. Non-emergency dentist trips will NOT BE AUTHORISED.
- 5) Always inform the school (on the first day) if your child is absent due to illness.

<u>Attendance this week</u> Another good week with attendance sitting at 97.4% which is identical to last week. Special mention to the Herons and Badgers for 100% this week.

- 6) Take family holidays outside term time. All holidays are unauthorised.
- 7) Talk to your child about school and take an interest in their school work (including homework).
- 8) Don't give the children a choice to stay at home. Explain to them the importance of good attendance.
- 9) Always support school staff in their efforts to control difficult or challenging behaviour.
- 10) Bring your child back to school following medical appointments.

## Coming soon - New after school clubs

We are sending home information today about two new after school clubs that we are in the process of organising.

#### Dance club

There will be a KS2 (Years 3 - 6) dance club ran by professional and qualified dance teachers. This club will start after the February half term and cost £27 for a 6 week block of lessons. Payments will need to be made directly to the dance company and before the start date. If you would like your child to attend, then please complete the reply slip and return to the admin office. The dance company will invoice you via email. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Thank you.


To see all club dates, please click 'Schedule' at the bottom of the page once you have selected your club.
